

Hwy 50 Holiday Trees Instruction Sheet **Check In Saturday, November 21st, 2020 at The Caboose**

Thank you for adopting a holiday tree. There are changes in the check in process this year so please read the instructions carefully. We look forward to a festive day.

- **No early check-ins allowed.** Appointment times will be assigned.
- Masks are required. Maintain 6 feet between groups and/or individuals. If you are sick please stay home.
- Groups not to exceed 8 people.
- **All participants must sign the attached liability waiver.**
- Only **ONE** designated representative will be allowed to check in for the group. The representative will provide the **COMPLETED** waivers for **each participant**. You will then receive your assigned tree location. **(No tree numbers will be given without the signed waivers).**
- If you do not check in by your appointment time and have not made **prior** arrangements your tree will be given to someone on the waiting list. The Chamber phone number is (530) 621-5885.
- Under NO circumstances NO ONE to be on Highway 50 or on the railings and barriers
- NO Tinsel, Garland or Lettering
- All trees must be decorated on the ground. We recommend that you bring a tree stand for decorating purposes (we will have people there to assist you with putting them on the stands)
- The ground is uneven so please do not use ladders, step stools are okay.
- Items must be secured (there is high wind from the Hwy). Zip Ties work well.
- You will need to bring 2 **exterior** extension cords (10 ft each) since the distance to the plugs varies from 4 – 18 ft.
- Please clean up your area after decorating.
- All decorations must be removed by Monday, **Jan 6th**. Trees are recycled which is why **you must remove ALL decorations and ties. And please return undecorated trees to the same location you picked it up from (Welcome to Placerville sign, Caboose, or behind Placerville Hardware).**
- **Your tree must be removed by the above date or you will not be eligible to reserve a tree next year.**
- Please be gentle with the electrical covers. They open from the bottom up.
- Please remember there is 2 hr free parking; additional time is only \$1/hour. Parking is **enforced** on Saturday. **DO NOT park in Main Street Tap House parking lot (not even to get your tree assignment)**
